### **Health and Safety Policy Statement**

NEJ Stevenson believes that the Health and Safety of its employees, contractors and the public is fundamental to the success of the Company. The Company recognises its moral and legal duty to protect the Health and Safety of its employees during the course of their employment, to protect employees of other employers, including clients, and to protect members of the public who may be affected by its work activities.

- Provide employees, contractors and visitors with suitable and adequate training for their health and safety
- Select contractors and subcontractors who have effective safety management systems for work at the Company's premises or its clients' premises
- Co-operate with and support our customers and landlords in developing safe working practices

Management and supervisory staff are required to provide and maintain safe conditions and systems of work. They are required to comply with the requirements of statutory and Company regulations, codes of practice and procedures, to acquaint employees under their control with these requirements and to monitor compliance with them.

All employees are required to recognise their responsibilities under the Health and Safety at Work, etc., Act 1974, to act responsibly and to do everything they can to prevent injury to themselves and other persons, and to co-operate in the implementation of this policy.

NEJ Stevenson is committed to continuous improvement of its health and safety performance by setting long-term objectives supported by a monitored programme of actions and targets and undertakes to publish details of performance, objectives and targets in periodic reports.
